

Dust Control Procedure

Hardin County

1. Dust control notice is published in County newspapers.
2. Landowner contacts Engineer's Office for:
 - a. A permit from the County if the landowner applies their own dust control, or
 - b. The name(s) and telephone number(s) of the approved contractor(s). (We require a certificate of insurance from the contractor with the following limits: \$100,000/\$300,000/\$50,000.)
3. Landowner receives permit form from the contractor. Landowner completes permit and returns it with the fee to the contractor.
4. Contractor sends the permit forms to the Engineer's Office. The Engineer sends the form to the Maintenance Superintendent for him to check, maintain requested location, and approve. After the road is maintained, the contractor is notified of approval.
5. The Maintenance Superintendent notifies the appropriate motorgrader operators so the material is not bladed out during normal maintenance.
