MINUTES – FEBRUARY 21, 2007

Chairman Jim Johnson called the meeting to order. Also present was Supervisors Ed Bear and Erv Miller, Rick Patrie and Kelly Collins.

Miller moved, Bear seconded to approve the minutes of February 14, 2007. Motion carried.

Bear moved, Miller seconded to approve the February 21, 2007 claims for payment. Motion carried.

Miller moved, Bear seconded to approve the sharing of the cost for the new sound system in the court rooms of the courthouse up to 1/3 of the cost. Motion carried.

Bear moved, Miller seconded to approve the union contract with Teamsters Local No. 650 effective July 1, 2007 – June 30, 2010. Roll Call Vote: “Ayes”: Bear, Miller and Johnson. “Nays”: None. Motion carried.

Miller moved, Bear seconded to approve the union contract with Public Professional & Maintenance Employees, Local 2003 effective July 1, 2007 – June 30, 2010. Roll Call Vote: “Ayes”: Miller, Bear and Johnson. “Nays”: None. Motion carried.

Bear moved, Miller seconded to approve the union contract with the Public Employee Bargaining Unit of Hardin County effective July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. Roll Call Vote: “Ayes”: Bear, Miller and Johnson. “Nays”: None. Motion carried.

Miller moved, Bear seconded to recommend the application for the animal feeding operation construction permit – Mike VanHove. With no written or oral objections being received it was then moved to send a letter of recommendation of the site to the DNR and to attach the normal paragraph in the letter with the Board’s concentration concerns. Motion carried.

Bear moved, Miller seconded to approve the six month, Class B Beer (BB) (Includes Wine Coolers) Liquor License for the Meadow Hills Golf Course in Iowa Falls, effective April 21, 2007. Motion carried.

Miller moved, Bear seconded to adjourn until February 28, 2007. Motion carried.
