Shall the Following Public Measure Be Adopted? Proposition S		
<p>Summary: To authorize extension of a one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the county of Hardin for school infrastructure projects from July 1, 2014 until December 31, 2022. A one percent (1%) local sales and services tax for school infrastructure projects shall be extended in the county of Hardin effective July 1, 2014. If not repealed, the tax will be in effect until December 31, 2022. The money received from the tax shall be spent for school infrastructure purposes including purchasing, building, furnishing, reconstructing, repairing, expanding, improving or remodeling of a schoolhouse or schoolhouses and additions thereto, gymnasium, stadium, field house, or school bus garage, and procuring a site or sites therefore or purchasing land to add to a site already owned, or procuring and improving a site for an athletic field, opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings, the purchase, lease or lease-purchase of buildings or equipment (including transportation and recreation equipment) as authorized by law, expenditures for energy conservation measures, or improving a site already owned for an athletic field, the payment or retirement of bonds issued for school infrastructure purposes or the payment or retirement of bonds issued under Iowa Code Section 423E.5, for debt reduction or property tax relief, or for any one or more of such purposes.</p>
